The Southern Campdrafting Association recognizes the importance of following basic needs of cattle and horses.

1. Access to food, water & shelter to maintain health and vigour.
2. Availability of facilities, space and company (of the animal's own kind) to allow for normal behavior.
3. Provision of conditions and treatment that avoid mental suffering.
4. Rapid identification and treatment of injury and disease.

It is therefore the policy of the Southern Campdrafting Association that animals used in Campdrafting shall be treated humanely and with proper consideration for their health and welfare.

The rules for the conduct of Campdrafting events are consistent with this policy and are specifically designed to prevent cruelty and minimize risk of injury or mistreatment.

This policy is intended to compliment and support existing legislation.
