### **Conditions of entry:**

- Prizemoney will be paid by direct deposit into your nominated bank account within 7 days of the draft.
- The Rich River Campdraft Club reserves the right to limit entry numbers according to cattle availability and also the number of runs each competitor may have on each event due to entry numbers.
- The Rich River Campdraft Club reserves the right to alter, change the program as it sees fit, but it will endeavour to run the events as shown on the program. The Club also reserves the right to refuse entry to either prospective competitors or members of the public.
- Approved Helmets must be worn – refer to SCA Rule Book "Helmet Requirements". Under 18 years of age must wear an approved helmet at all times whilst mounted. \$16 cattle levy included in entry fees of each event.
- Prize money – 60% payback. Ribbons to 6<sup>th</sup> place.
- Full catering and bar facilities will be available over the weekend, no eftpos available.
